### An eventful year!

#### **JANUARY**

#### PILOT PROGRAM IN AARHUS

In the beginning of year we launched a new pilot project in Aarhus by two new staff members! Our new Aarhus location planned two programs for women; one for digital beginners and one for tech, focusing on data analytics.

Planning and developing corporate courses with Microsoft, we added Cloud Computing, Data Analytics, and Data Engineering to the tech program with certifications in Azure.

#### STUDENT IMPACT

Record high number of accepted students of 110 students in ReDI DK - 80 students learning advanced technology and 30 students learning basic computer skills.
